

BELFOREST WATER SYSTEM SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Deadline: Friday, February 13, 2026 at 4:00 pm Applications must be in office by this deadline.

Belforest Water System is offering five (5) \$1,000 scholarships for 2026 graduates in our service area. **To be eligible for a BWS scholarship, the student must reside full time in the Belforest Water System coverage area in a home that is provided water from BWS.** One scholarship is reserved for a student who is seeking training/education in a career/technical field. Home address verification will be required.

These scholarships are granted only to high school seniors. The student may attend a four-year college/university, a community college, and/or a technical/vocational/trade school. Funds will be transmitted to the school of choice for the student's use following enrollment verification.

To apply for this scholarship, please download a scholarship application packet from www.belforestwater.com and submit to the main office at 9080 County Road 64, Daphne, AL. Scholarship information will also be provided to local high school counselors. Only fully completed scholarship packets will be accepted – a checklist is included.

Essays will be double blind scored by a two-person jury. Names will be withheld from the essay scoring panel. Essay scores along with other criteria will be tallied, and the top five scorers will be awarded a scholarship.

ESSAY REQUIREMENTS AND GUIDELINES

Each applicant must submit an essay of approximately 500 words (one page single spaced or two pages double spaced) answering the question below. Essays will be graded in a double-blind format, so the essay may not include your name or other identifiers (listing family members' names, etc.).

Essay Topic: Who you are is closely tied to where you are from. How has growing up/living in the Belforest area affected who you are today AND how you will contribute to society in the future?

Grading Rubric:

Purpose	Meets requirements of essay contest; focuses on topic and gives concrete examples	15 points
Idea	Overall quality of topic discussion; quality of content provided	50 points
Organization	Essay is easy to read, well organized and flows through topic requirement	25 points
Grammar	Follows grammar rules, spelling, and basic English rules	10 points
Total Points Awarded		100 points
